**Board of Directors Meeting**

Meeting called to order at 7:30pm

Items Discussed:

- Player Clinics:
  - Lori provided instructor names and hours for pitching clinic to Joanne for payment
  - Lori to confirm instructors for hitting clinic with Brad for payment
- Player Registration/Try-outs
  - Shelly to check with Woodley on possibly changing 12U try-outs to a later date.
  - Registration Update
    - 10U – Interested Coaches: Jeff Husom, Julie Johnson, and Nick Martini
      - 31 registered at 10U. Still recruiting players
      - Carrie advised that BP Fastpitch might have extra players at 10U, 12U, and 14U and tryouts are this upcoming weekend.
      - 2-3 players are pending, given contact made with Shelly
    - 12U – Interested Coach – Troy Proctor
      - 17 registered at this level. 2 are eligible for 10U, Shelly to contact to discuss 10U eligibility
      - We only have 2 evaluators currently. Shelly to check with Coach Woodley about evaluators. Lori to contact Brad to see if he can find volunteers if needed.
      - We would only allow up to 13 players per team, so additional registration from BP would only be allowed to this number.
      - Shelly will check with Coach Woodley/Matt Mattson on changing the date of try-outs
    - 14U – Interested Coaches – Shelly Paulsrud, Patty Maus, Tom Sacco, Rick Mingo
      - 31 registered at this level
      - 4 – 9 graders
    - 16U – Interested Coaches – Mike Herron, Mike Martharler
      - Set-up meeting with Coach Woodley
  - March 15 and 17<sup>th</sup> still reserved at CPHS for U12 tryouts
  - Deposit was given to Chris Kloepfner for uniforms
  - April 6<sup>th</sup> is the North Suburban Coaches Meeting - 6p – 10U and 12U and 8p – 14U and 16U. No sanction for any group, i.e. ASA or USSSA. Will all be sanctioned as NAFA. Suburban has dropped fees to \$400 from \$440 to allow for any additional ASA registrations needed. ASA umpires can umpire non-ASA sanctioned league games. There was motion to remove the dropped third strike, but the vote failed. For 16 and 18U levels, the mound is moving back to 43' for this summer league. Motion to have metal cleats was approved.
  - Suburban leagues will start as follows: May 10 – 10U and 12U, May 24 - 14U, and June 7<sup>th</sup> for 16 and 18U
  - 10U and 12U – State Qualified June 25-27 and State July 9-11
  - 14U and 16U – State Qualifier July 9-11 and State July 17-18
  - Gate fees for State Qualifier is \$80 and State is \$100
  - Waiting on insurance from Suburban League
  - Approach Coach Woodley about pitching coach for future pitching clinics
  - Have 14U and 16U come in for the 10U and 12U parent/player meeting to try-on uniforms
  - Carrie to contact sportswear vendor to send pictures to post on website for ordering.
  - Reconfirm gym and cafeteria for parent/player meeting.
  - Will confirm next boardmember meeting based on 12U evaluations.
